**Neighborhood Takeout** is a collaboration between NCJW, the University of Minnesota Continuing Education program and Neighborhood House, in which we provide nutrition education to immigrant mothers with young children, along with healthy food for consumption on weekends. Neighborhood Takeout has been highly successful and every year it is increasingly popular among participants.

**Girls on the Move**, our nationally recognized program that educates young girls on the importance of good self-esteem and body image by helping them develop self-empowerment tools and motivating

them to thrive, all while having fun!

**Stuff For School**, which provides school supplies to more than 16,000 low-income St. Paul public school students at the start of each school year. The students are always proud to have new supplies.

**Luggage For Freedom**, in which NCJW collects new and gently used luggage and linens and donates them to families at local shelters to use when they depart the shelter and begin life in a new home.

**Ongoing Advocacy Work**, in which we lobby government leaders on critical social and political issues, such as child welfare, women's rights, and reproductive freedom, and provide community-wide educational opportunities to learn about these issues.

**NCJW's National Programs**, including the Women and Gender Studies Program and Women's Studies Forum at Tel Aviv University, Our University Yad

B'yad grant program in Israel, Benchmark: NCJW's Campaign to Save Roe, and Plan A: NCJW's Campaign for Contraceptive Access.
